### Pedestrian access in Liphook.

The map shows roads and access routes open to vehicles in black. —

Pedestrian and/or cycle paths are coloured green. —

Pedestrian crossings shown as follows

Zebra crossing by purple circled = (Z)

Pelican crossing by red circled = (P)

Central island crossing by brown bar —

Crossing points with lowered kerb and/or surface markings and/or bollards by pink bar —

Large numbers in developments, not all shown

### Additional links between the six main roads:

Housing north of Haslemere road has 4 points of access to Radford Park and so to London road.

A path to the Recreation Ground from Malthouse Meadows links Haslemere and London roads.

A footpath from the library links the Haslemere and London roads more directly.

A path to the Peak Centre car park links Chiltlee Manor, Haslemere road to Midhurst road.

A path links Manor Fields, off Haslemere road to Huron Drive and then Midhurst road.

A path through Fletcher's Field links the Portsmouth road to the Midhurst road

Longmoor road is linked to Portsmouth road via Victoria Way and The Firs.

### Areas with 'internal' footpaths

Houses accessed from The Avenue via Yoomans Lane or Lark Rise have a network of footpaths.

Cunns farm has two internal footpaths that join together to give access to the Midhurst road.

The Berg Estate has a footpath from the south west corner of Chiltley Way to the Midhurst road and another links Chestnut Close to Chiltley Lane.







**Understanding the road traffic problem.**

Six roads meet in the area known as the Square.

Each of these roads and its contributory roads has been given a different colour on this map:-

- Purple for the Longmoor Road
- Blue for the Headley Road
- Green for the London Road
- Yellow for the Haslemere Road
- Brown for the Midhurst Road
- Red for the Portsmouth Road

Any roads linking different coloured areas are coloured black.

Residents in the purple, blue and green areas are able to travel within those areas without going through the square by using The Avenue and/or Tower Road.

**Residents in the purple, blue and green areas must go via the Square to reach the yellow, brown or red areas.**

Residents in the red or brown areas can travel within those areas without going through the Square by using Station Road.

**Residents in the red or brown areas must go through the square to reach the yellow, purple, blue or green areas.**

Residents in the yellow area have no road links to other areas.

**Residents in the yellow area can only reach the other areas by going through the Square.**

The low number of alternative link roads means that a very high proportion of local journeys made by residents have to go through the Square.
