6. To Discuss and Select a Consultancy to write Policies and Core NDP

6.1 The Chair provided an overview of the current status of the policies:

26 policies have been created and 14 have been reviewed by the external consultancy AECOM

- a. Steering Group has decided a substantial amount of time and resource in developing these policies
- b. It has previously been agreed that the remaining policies will need to be outsourced as the workload is beyond the time and resources of the current Steering Group team
- c. policies that are going to pass NDP Examination
- 6.2 Progress in appointing a consultant to deliver the remaining polices:
- a. 6 consultancies have been approached
- b. The Steering Group has previously worked with AECOM and Feria however Aecom do not offer a policy writing service and FERIA are too busy
- c. Locality provides funding for consultancy work of this nature

The Chair proposed Alison Eardley as the preferred consultant. AL seconded; all 8/8 in favour

7. To Discuss and Agree NDP Scope and Objectives

7.1 The Chair gave a presentation outlining a range of considerations and themes for general discussion. This included the "Win strategy, policy driven benefits and the scope of the NDP". The Chair confirmed that the NDP scope had got wider and deeper than its original brief.

- Agree to include all sites in the NDP as outlined by "Slide 17" categorised as ... TBA.
- · Agreed the benefits associated with having an NDP
- Agreed the Policy Driven Benefits approach delivered by NDP Projects.
- Agreed to pursue *Option 5* Policies, Benefits + Large Sites* (>10 Properties), Allocated Sites + SEA, HRA....subject to affordable housing/specialist on small sites
- We have not yet agreed the revised Vision Statement or Revised Measurable Objectives.
- Agree the concept of "Subject to..." which includes -
 - Use a working assumption to discuss planned housing numbers as per Census history + 6% ONS population growth to 2041.
 - Enforce EHDC CP32 Infrastructure Policy for all new developments
 - Pay for NDP Benefits and CP32 via Developer Contribution [S106] and CIL funds
 - Work with and develop INTEREST GROUPS to provide acceptable build conditions
- 7.2 The Chair invited questions from the public on issues around this discussion.

Questions from the public:

- Q1. Will those numbers reduce the base on the SDNP being limited?
- A1. A letter has gone to parliament about National Park housing restrictions?
- Q2. Is house price inflation a good thing for the young population?
- A2. No not really but NDP can't control national growth
- Q3. What is the allocated number of affordable houses?
- A3. NDP policy will be 40% but will need conversations with allocations team at EHDC
